

Camosun College Trades Awards for 2018

The Victoria Bailliage of La Chaîne des Rôtisseurs awards a \$500 bursary each year to a student studying for their Chef's Red Seal in the Culinary Arts Programme at Camosun College. The National Bailliage normally matches the amount given by Victoria, such that we can often award two bursaries.

At the AGM, the Victoria Bailliage Members approved our contribution of \$500 for 2018. However, the college advised that they were holding \$900 of Chaîne contributions which was not awarded in prior years. The Conseil agreed to not make another contribution in 2018 and the College was charged with the responsibility of nominating one or two possible recipients.

The Chaîne's award is presented to a Professional Cook 2 Foundation Apprentice who has shown great progress with exemplary attitude and has consistently demonstrated a desire to learn while achieving above average marks.
